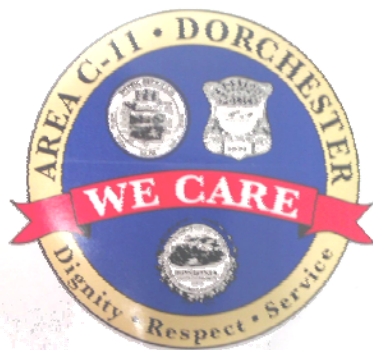

VIN ETCHING PROGRAM

Marks every window with your V.I.N
(Vehicle Identification Number)



On **October 29, 2011** the Boston Police Department District C-11, in conjunction with the Savin Hill Historical Advisers, and the Governor's Auto Theft Task Force will sponsor an Auto Theft Prevention Program called "VIN Etching". The event will be held at **Peter's Towing, 150 Freeport St. Dorchester Ma** from **10am-2pm**. The process, which takes approximately 5-10 minutes, etches the V.I.N. (Vehicle Identification Number) of your vehicle into all the glass windows of your vehicle by using a computer generated stencil and a glass reactive acid treatment. This provides a visible deterrent to theft and can be good for a discount of up to 15% off on your comprehensive auto insurance.

In order to participate you need to have the following items:

1. A vehicle with a current and valid registration
2. \$10.00 cash, which is paid to the Auto Theft Strike Force to defray the cost of materials.
3. A valid license to operate a motor vehicle in your possession.
